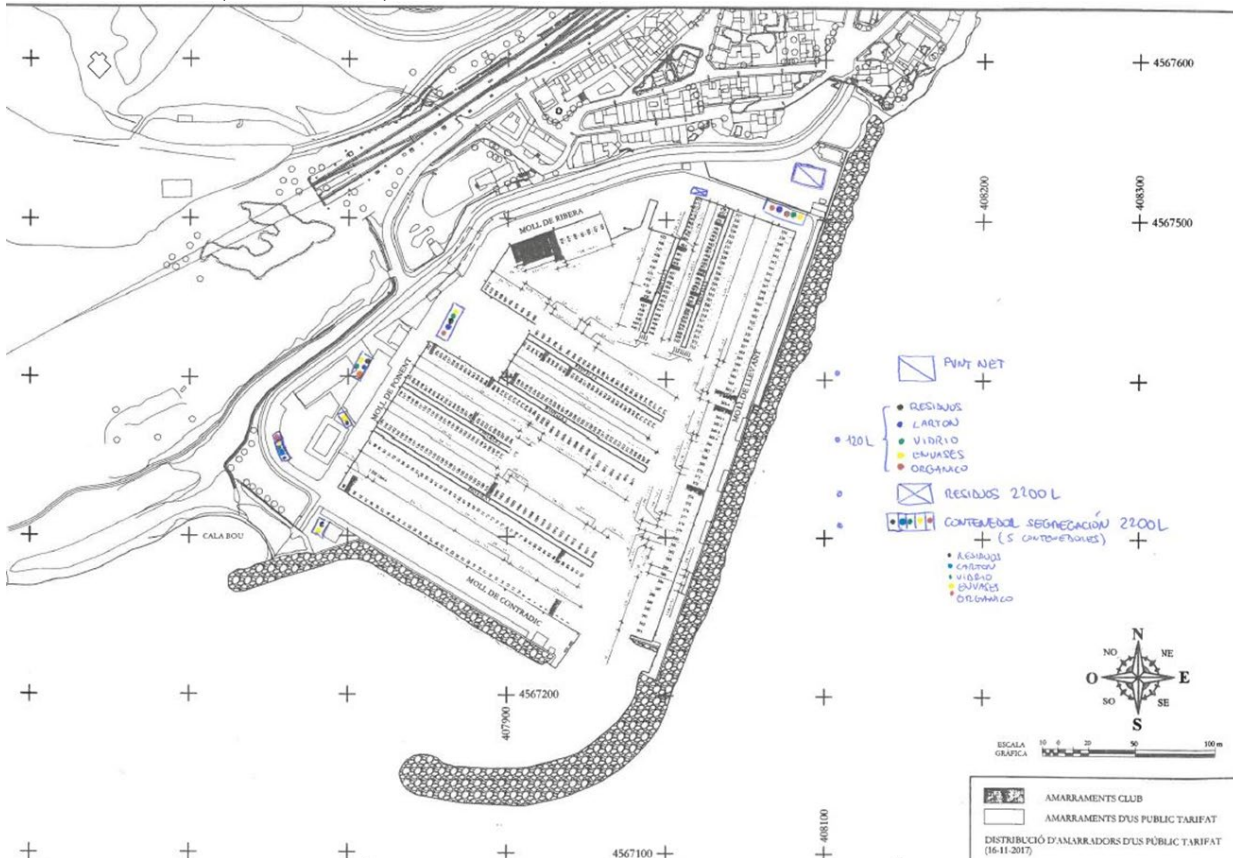


Location map of waste reception facilities

List of waste collected at the port:

1. Used oils
1. Batteries
2. Contaminated metal containers
3. Contaminated plastic packaging
4. Fibers or fabrics of animal, vegetable or synthetic origin
5. Oil and fuel filters
6. Paint sludge and varnishes
7. Aqueous liquid waste containing hazardous substances
8. Dissolvents
9. Absorbents
10. Traces of paint
11. Non-halogenated sludge
12. Lamps, bulbs and fluorescent lights
13. Banal

14. Cardboard and paper, packaging, glass and organic
15. Iron
16. Wood

Contact points of installation managers

Waste delivery procedure to port facilities

1. Clean point: ask for the key at the dry dock.
2. Hydrocarbon water: contact dry dock.
3. Bilge waters: contact dry dock.
4. Iron: make use of the specific container located in the dry dock area.
5. Banal: make use of the islands for collecting this type of waste.
6. Domestic: make use of the islands for collecting this type of waste.
